

1. The Commission has received a report from the
 2. Committee on the Administration of Justice, which
 3. states that the current system of judicial
 4. appointments in the United Kingdom is inadequate
 5. and that a reform is necessary. The Commission
 6. is therefore considering the possibility of
 7. recommending the establishment of a new
 8. independent body to oversee the process of
 9. appointing judges to the higher courts.
 10. This would ensure that the process is
 11. transparent and that the best possible
 12. candidates are selected for the positions.
 13. The Commission also notes the importance
 14. of maintaining the independence of the
 15. judiciary and the need for a system that
 16. is free from any form of external pressure
 17. or influence. It is therefore essential
 18. that any proposed reform should be designed
 19. to strengthen the public confidence in the
 20. legal system as a whole.
